Adult Parent/Guardian Agreement:

As the Parent or Guardian of the above listed camper, this registration has my approval. It is agreed that camp fees will be paid in advance and will not be refunded if a camper leaves for any reason other than sickness. When granted, a refund will be one-half of the unused amount. It is understood that there will be no discrimination for service to any camper because of race, color, or national origin. However, the Camp Director may reject an application because of the past conduct of the camper, dismiss a camper because of the past conduct of the camper, or may dismiss a camper for violation of camp rules. While the camp takes reasonable precautions, it is agreed that the camp assumes no responsibility for the camper's personal property and is released from liability in connection with medical care or service except in the cases covered by the Camp's Camper Insurance. It is understood that upon arrival to camp, each camper will be required to undergo a screening for head lice, and that any camper found with head lice will not be permitted to stay. In case of emergency, I give permission for the camper named on this registration form to receive emergency medical treatment at a hospital, clinic, or other health care provider. I understand that compensation will not be received for the use of any pictures, video, or other media containing the above listed camper in camp promotional material and release the camp from all liability concerning the use of such promotional material.

Registration & Cost - Early Bird Savings!

Send total camp cost with the Camper Registration Form. If camper registration is postmarked before May 1, camp cost is \$130. If camper registration is postmarked after April 30, camp cost is \$140. Camp cost includes camper canteen and a camp session t-shirt. If a camper attends more than one camp session, a different Camper Registration Form must be filled out for EACH camper for EACH camp session.

Final camp registration will be Sunday afternoon for each camp session from 2:30 PM to 5:00 PM. Camp registration will NOT start until 2:30 PM!

An early pre-registration is important... and can save you money!

Pick-Up Time

Campers should be picked up on Saturday of each summer camp session between 8:30 AM and 10:00 AM. Camp staff is dismissed after 10:00 AM on Saturday. It is important that all campers are picked up from camp **Before 10:00 AM.**

Evening Worship Services

Evening worship services are conducted each summer camp session Sunday thru Friday. Guests are welcome to attend these worship services. Please check with camp director for actual scheduled time.

Prescriptions & Medications

The Camp Director or an Assigned Staff Member (Camp Nurse) should be notified of all prescriptions or medicines to be taken by a camper during a camp session.

Day Camp / Winter Camp

Day Camp for grades 1-4 is offered June 15-17. Those interested should mail in the Camp Registration Form by Saturday, May 31st to receive further Day Camp Information from Director Steve Gregg. The total cost for the three days of Day Camp is \$20.

Winter Camp for grades 7-12 is offered December 30, 2009-Jan 2, 2010. Registration Forms are due by Nov. 30th, 2009. Winter Camp cost is \$50.

What to Bring to Camp Lu-Jo

- Bible.
- Clothes for a Week.

Camp Location

Camp Lu-Jo is located in northern Cotton County, about sixteen miles southwest of Lawton, Oklahoma. From Lawton, the camp may be reached as follows:

1. Go **South** on **I-44** (H.E. Bailey Turnpike)
2. Take **Exit 30** (Faxon/Chattanooga) and then turn **WEST** toward Faxon and Chattanooga on **Highway 36** for **about 5 miles** (until just before Highway 36 begins to curve southwest).
3. Go **SOUTH** on a blacktop/gravel road (Hurst Road) for **4 miles**.
4. Go **EAST** on a gravel road (**Logue Chapel Road**) for **1 mile**:
then go **SOUTH** on a gravel road (**82nd St**) for **1.5 miles**.
5. Camp Lu-Jo will be on your left.
